INTRODUCTION

A book entitled "The History of Panikulam Family" written by Rev. Fr. Joseph Panikulam of Paroor in Malayalam was published in the year 1938. An up-dated version of the work was again published in the year 1987 in English. The history recorded in these books was confined to the migration of Mr. Joseph Panikulam from Moozhikulam to North Parur in the year 1750 and the genealogy of his descendants centered around Parur, Ambazhakad and Kattoor. An association of the family members of this branch also came into existence. It was on the prompting of Mr. Abraham George Panikulam of Kattoor, the president of this association that efforts were made by me to establish the linkages with the other known branches of the family.

The search was rewarding. Not only that the linkages between Moozhikulam, Parur and Puthenchira branches could be established but also the early history of the family, dating back to 7th century A.D., duly supported by documentary evidences, could be unearthed. This book reproduces these findings and the genealogy of the family now centered around Elavoor - Kunnappillissery near Moozhikulam, North Parur, Ambazhakad, Kattoor and Puthenchira with 31-10-94 as the reference date.

Mr. Abraham George, the president and other committee members of the present family association deserve special appreciation for their initiative and support in expanding the base of the association to encompass all the known branches of the family. Note-worthy is the contribution made by Mr. Paul Joseph in updating the material of the existing book.

A committee of the family members of Puthenchira branch was formed with Mr. Antony Mathai, the present Karanavar of the branch as convenor to co-ordinate the collection of data and other connected activities. The assistance and support offered by the convenor and the committee were crucial to the successful completion of the task and merit special mention.

Mr. Kunjuvareed Mathai was the convenor of the committee formed in Elavoor Kunnappillissery. Aged 88, he is the present Karanavar of the entire Panikulam family. The enthusiasm and warmth with which he received the idea when it was proposed to him and the depth of information dug out from his memory bank have greatly contributed to unearthing the past history.

Rev. Fr. Abraham Padayatti, the Vicar of Moozhikulam Forane Church, displayed commendable interest and patience in scanning the documents of the church along with the search team. We are grateful to him for his assistance and co-operation.

Our thanks are due to M/s Nirmala Offset Printers for the execution of the assigned task of printing this book within the stipulated time frame.

It is with great contentment that I dedicate this book for the identity and unity of our posterity.

ആമുഖം

പറുർ ശാഖയിൽപ്പെട്ട ബഹുമാനിക്കുന്ന ഔസേപ്പച്ചൻ മലയാളത്തിൽ എഴുതിയ പാനികുളം കുടുംബചരിത്രം 1938ൽ പ്രസിദ്ധീകരിക്കപ്പെട്ടു. അതു പുതുക്കി ഇംഗ്ലീഷിലേക്ക് പരിഭാഷപ്പെടുത്തി "ദി ഹിസ്റ്ററി ഓഫ് പാനികുളം ഫാമിലി" എന്ന പേരിൽ 1957ൽ പ്രകാശനം ചെയ്യപ്പെട്ടു. മുഴിക്കുളത്തുനിന്ന് പറുർ വന്ന് താമസമാക്കിയ ജോസഫ് പാനികുളത്തിന്റെയും പറുർ അമ്പഴക്കാട് കാട്ടൂർ എന്നീ സ്ഥലങ്ങളെ കേന്ദ്രീകരിച്ച് താമസമാക്കിയ അദ്ദേഹത്തിന്റെ പിൻഗാമികളുടെയും ചരിത്രമാണ് ഈ പുസ്തകങ്ങളിൽ രേഖപ്പെടുത്തിയിരിക്കുന്നത്. ഈ ശാഖകളിലെ അംഗങ്ങളുടെ ഒരു അസോസിയേഷനും നിലവിൽ നിന്നു. അതിന്റെ അദ്ധ്യക്ഷനായ പാനികുളം ജോർജ്ജ് മകൻ അബ്രാഹമിന്റെ താൽപര്യപ്രകാരമാണ് പാനികുളം കുടുംബത്തിന്റെ അറിയപ്പെടുന്ന മറ്റ് ശാഖകളുമായുള്ള ബന്ധങ്ങൾ കണ്ടെത്താനുള്ള ഉദ്യമത്തിൽ ഞാൻ ഏർപ്പെട്ടത്.

ഈ ശ്രമങ്ങൾ വളരെ ഫലവത്തായി. മുഴിക്കുളം, പറുർ, പുത്തൻചീറ എന്നീ ശാഖകൾ തമ്മിലുള്ള ബന്ധങ്ങൾ സ്ഥിരീകരിക്കുക മാത്രമല്ല ക്രിസ്തുവർഷം 7-ാം നൂറ്റാണ്ട് മുതലുള്ള പാനികുളം കുടുംബത്തിന്റെ പുരാതന ചരിത്രം രേഖകളുടെ അടിസ്ഥാനത്തിൽ കണ്ടെത്താനും കഴിഞ്ഞു. ഈ ചരിത്ര സത്യങ്ങളും മുഴിക്കുളത്തിനടുത്തുള്ള ഇളവൂർ കുന്ന്കുളിശ്ശേരി എന്നീ പ്രദേശങ്ങളേയും വടക്കൻ പറുർ, അമ്പഴക്കാട്, കാട്ടൂർ, പുത്തൻചീറ എന്നീ സ്ഥലങ്ങളെയും കേന്ദ്രീകരിച്ച് വളർന്നിട്ടുള്ള പാനികുളം കുടുംബത്തിന്റെ 1994 ഒക്ടോബർ 31 വരെയുള്ള ചരിത്രവും ആണ് ഈ പുസ്തകത്തിൽ ചിത്രീകരിച്ചിരിക്കുന്നത്.

അറിയപ്പെടുന്ന എല്ലാ ശാഖകളേയും ചേർത്ത് അസോസിയേഷൻ വിഹുരീകരിക്കുന്നതിന് തുടക്കം കുറിക്കുകയും മുന്നോട്ട് പോകാൻ സഹായിക്കുകയും ചെയ്ത അദ്ധ്യക്ഷൻ ജോർജ്ജ് അബ്രാഹമും മറ്റ് അംഗങ്ങളും പ്രത്യേക അഭിനന്ദനം അർഹിക്കുന്നു. നിലവിലുള്ള പുസ്തകത്തിലെ പറുർ ശാഖാചരിത്രം പുതുക്കി എഴുതിയ ജോസഫ് മകൻ പോളിന്റെ പ്രയത്നങ്ങൾ ഏടുത്ത് പറയേണ്ടതാണ്.

ചരിത്രം ശേഖരിക്കാനും മറ്റ് പ്രവർത്തനങ്ങൾക്കും വേണ്ടി പുത്തൻചീറ ശാഖയിലെ അംഗങ്ങളുടെ ഒരു കമ്മിറ്റി ഇപ്പോഴത്തെ കാരണവരായ മത്തായി മകൻ ആന്റണിയുടെ നേതൃത്വത്തിൽ രൂപംകൊണ്ടു. അദ്ദേഹത്തിന്റെയും കമ്മിറ്റിയുടെയും സഹായ സഹകരണങ്ങൾ ഈ യത്നത്തിന്റെ പൂർത്തീകരണത്തിന് അനിവാര്യമായിരുന്നു എന്ന കാര്യം ഊന്നിപറയാം.

THE EARLY HISTORY

Prior to the arrival of the Portuguese in the Kerala coast and the establishment of their hegemony over the then native Syrian Christians, the latter enjoyed all the privileges and social status of the non-converts. Occasional conversions to the Christian faith also continued during this period on account of different reasons like the influence of their converted kith and kin, miraculous experiences, rivalry between the non-converts and the differences with the rulers and the sub-ruler cliques. Such conversions were non-events and did not create any social commotion. The rulers of the day were, to a large extent, unconcerned even about the conversion of some of the temples into churches when the converts had decisive controlling authority over such institutions.

Prominent among the many Hindu temples which lost their important followers by their conversion to Christianity was a historic and ancient one situated in Thiru Moozhikulam. The Christian family of Panikulam is believed to have originated by the acceptance of Christian faith by one of the few principalities who controlled the administration of this temple.

The exact cause for the conversion and its time are unknown. ★ However, according to the documents available in the St. Mary's Church Moozhikulam, this ancient church was established in the year 601 A.D. and its 6th vicar was Rev. Fr. Iltoop from Panikulam family. It can, therefore, be safely assumed that the conversion of the family to Christianity had taken place during the 7th century A.D. or earlier.

There is a large area in Elavoor near Moozhikulam comprising of an impressive pond surrounded by a stretch of paddy field on one side and coconut farms on the other three sides known by the title 'Paranikulam' and inherited by the present generation of the family. It is learnt that the pond was once a private bathing place adjoining a princely mansion protected by a fort. The fort as well as the steps leading to the pond were made of polished stones and the removal of their remains for use elsewhere is vivid in the memory of the living members. It is believed that the inhabitants of this princely mansion were the Hindu ancestors of the Panikulam family. The original title of the family during its Hindu days is understood to have been Paranikulam which by the passage of time got abbreviated to 'Panikulam'.

The Christian Panikulam family thrived in Moozhikulam. The members are settled in the adjoining localities of Elavoor, Kunnappillissery, and Parakadavu all of which once formed parts of moozhikulam parish and their history forms Part-1 of this book.

The first recorded migration of a family member from Moozhikulam area is the settlement of Joseph S/o. Kunjuvareed in North Parur around the year 1750 A.D. His movement out of Moozhikulam was, as per tradition, prompted by some conflict with the local 'Naduvazhi'. From N. Parur the family spread out to Ambazhakad, Kattoor (two wings) and Thundathukdavu and from Kattoor to Edathurthy. The second part of the book is the history of this Parur branch.

The second recorded movement out of Moozhikulam is of Kunjicheria; S/o. Mathai who on marrying Rosamma D/o. Mr. Varky, Alakkat Kannampuzha settled in Puthenchira around the year 1825 A.D. The history of this Puthenchira branch is recorded in Part-3 of this book.

There were few more movements of members out of Moozhikulam. However, considering the limited number of members involved, their history has been recorded as a part of Moozhikulam branch itself, ie. in Part-1 of the book.

പുരാതന ചരിത്രം

പോർച്ചുഗീസുകാർ കേരളത്തിൽ വന്ന് അവരുടെ മേൽക്കോയ്മ അടിച്ചേൽപ്പിക്കുന്നതുവരെ അന്നത്തെ തദ്ദേശികൾ ത്യാനികൾ അവരുടെ മതമാറ്റത്തിന് മുമ്പ് ഉണ്ടായിരുന്ന എല്ലാ അവകാശങ്ങളും സമൂഹപരവികളും അനുവദിച്ചിരുന്നു. ക്രിസ്ത്യന്മാരും സ്വീകരിച്ച ബന്ധുക്കളുടെ സ്വാധീനം, അത്ഭുതപ്രവർത്തനങ്ങളുടെ സാക്ഷ്യം, അക്രൈസ്തവർ തമ്മിലുണ്ടായിരുന്ന മത്സരം, വലിയതും ചെറിയതും ആയ നാടുവാഴികളോടുള്ള ചേർച്ചകുറവ് അങ്ങിനെ പലകാരണങ്ങളാലും ക്രിസ്ത്യന്മാരുമായിരുന്നെങ്കിലും മതം മാറ്റം നടന്നു കൊണ്ടിരുന്നു. ഈ മതംമാറ്റങ്ങൾ കോളിബ്രക്ക അൾ ഒന്നും സൃഷ്ടിക്കാതെ സാധാരണ സംഭവങ്ങളായി അക്കാലത്ത് തുടർന്നു. അങ്ങിനെ ക്രിസ്ത്യന്മാരും സ്വീകരിച്ച വ്യക്തികൾക്ക് നിർണ്ണായകമായ അധികാരാവകാശങ്ങൾ നിലനിന്നിരുന്ന ചില അനേകങ്ങൾ പള്ളികളായി മാറിയതിൽ അന്നത്തെ നല്ലൊരു പങ്ക് നാടുവാഴികളും വലിയ ആൾക്കും പ്രകടിപ്പിച്ചിരുന്നു.

ക്രിസ്ത്യന്മാരും സ്വീകരിച്ചതുമായ പ്രധാന അനുയായികൾ നഷ്ടപ്പെട്ട അനേകങ്ങളിൽ പ്രമുഖമായ ഒന്നാണ് പരിത്ര പ്രധാനമായതും പഴമ ഏറിയതുമായ തിരുമുഴിക്കുളം അമ്പലം. ഈ അമ്പലത്തിന്റെ ഭരണാധികാരി കൈയടക്കിയിരുന്ന ചുരുക്കം ചില നാടുവാഴി കുടുംബങ്ങളിൽ ഒന്നിന്റെ ക്രിസ്ത്യന്മാരും സ്വീകരണമായി ക്രിസ്ത്യൻ ചാനിക്കുളം കുടുംബത്തിന്റെ ഉൽഭവം എന്ന് വിശ്വസിക്കപ്പെടുന്നു. ഈ കുടുംബം ക്രിസ്ത്യന്മാരും സ്വീകരിച്ച കൃത്യം കാലയളവു അതിനുള്ളകാരണങ്ങളും അറിവായിട്ടില്ല. ★ പക്ഷെ മുഴിക്കുളം പള്ളിയിൽ സൂക്ഷിച്ചിട്ടുള്ള രേഖകളനുസരിച്ച് ക്രിസ്ത്യന്മാർക്കും മേൽ സ്ഥിരപിതയായ ഈ പുരാതനപള്ളിയുടെ ആറാമത്തെ വികാരി ബപാതികുളം ഇട്ടുപ്പച്ചൻ ആയിരുന്നു. അതുകൊണ്ട് കുടുംബം ക്രിസ്ത്യന്മാരും സ്വീകരിച്ചത് ക്രിസ്ത്യന്മാർക്കും 7-ാം നൂറ്റാണ്ടിനോടടുത്തു ആയിരുന്നു എന്ന് നിസ്തർക്കം അനുമാനിക്കാം.

മുഴിക്കുളത്തിനടുത്ത് എളവൂരിൽ ഇപ്പോഴത്തെ കുടുംബത്തോട് വഴിക്കാർക്ക് പരമ്പരാഗതമായി ഉടമസ്ഥാവകാശം വഹിച്ചിട്ടുള്ള "പാറണിക്കുളം" എന്ന് അറിയപ്പെടുന്ന ഒരു സ്ഥലം സ്ഥിതിചെയ്യുന്നു. ഒരു വശത്ത് നെൽപ്പാടും മറ്റ് മൂന്നുവശങ്ങളിലും തെങ്ങിൻതോട്ടം വലയം ചെയ്തു കിടക്കുന്ന ആകർഷണീയമായ ഒരു കുളമാണ് നല്ല വിസ്തീർണ്ണമുള്ള ഈ സ്ഥലത്തിന്റെ പ്രത്യേകത. പുരാതനകാലത്ത് ഒരു കോട്ടകൊണ്ട് സംരക്ഷിക്കപ്പെട്ടിരുന്ന ഒരു നാടുവാഴിക്കൊട്ടാരത്തിന്റെ സ്വകാര്യ കുളസ്ഥലമായിരുന്നു ഈ കുളം എന്ന് വിശ്വസിക്കപ്പെടുന്നു. കോട്ടയും കുളത്തിനോടടുത്തു നടകളും മിനുസപ്പെടുത്തിയ കല്ലുകൾക്കൊണ്ടാണ് ഉണ്ടാക്കിയിരുന്നത്. അവയുടെ അവശിഷ്ടങ്ങൾ മറ്റു പണികൾക്ക് എടുത്തു മാറ്റിയത് ഇന്നത്തെ തലവറക്കാരെ കൃത്യമായി ഓർക്കുന്നു. ഈ നാടുവാഴിക്കൊട്ടാരത്തിലെ താമസക്കാരായിരുന്നു ചാനിക്കുളം കുടുംബത്തിന്റെ ഹിന്ദുപൂർവ്വികർ എന്നാണ് വിശ്വാസം. കുടുംബത്തിന്റെ ഹിന്ദുനാളുകളിലെ ആദ്യപേര് 'പാറണിക്കുളം' എന്നായിരുന്നു എന്നും കാലക്രമത്തിൽ അത് മാറിച്ച് "ചാനിക്കുളം" എന്നായി മാറി എന്നുമാണ് കരുതപ്പെടുന്നത്.

കൃസ്ത്യൻ ചാനിക്കുളം കുടുംബം മുഴിക്കുളത്ത് താഴെ വളർന്നു. ആദ്യകാലങ്ങളിൽ മുഴിക്കുളംപള്ളി ഇടവകയിൽ ഉൾപ്പെട്ടിരുന്ന എളവൂർ, കുന്നപ്പിള്ളിമറ്റം, ചാറക്കുറവ് എന്നീ പ്രദേശങ്ങളിൽ ഇപ്പോൾ താമസിക്കുന്ന കുടുംബാംഗങ്ങളുടെ ചരിത്രമാണ് ഈ പുസ്തകത്തിന്റെ ഒന്നാം ഭാഗം.

ക്രിസ്ത്യന്മാർക്കും 1750ൽ കുഞ്ഞുവനിയിന്റെ മകൻ ജോസഫ് വടക്കൻ പാർട്ടിൽ താമസമാക്കിയതാണ് രേഖപ്പെടുത്തപ്പെട്ടിട്ടുള്ള ആദ്യത്തെ സ്ഥലം മാറ്റം. നാടുവാഴിയുമായുള്ള അഭിപ്രായവ്യത്യാസമാണ് സ്ഥലം വിട്ടുപോകാൻ അദ്ദേഹത്തെ പ്രേരിപ്പിച്ചത് എന്നാണ് പരമ്പരാഗതമായ അറിവ്. ചാനിക്കുളം കുടുംബം പിന്നീട് പാർട്ടി നിന്ന് അമ്പലക്കോട്ടയിലും, രണ്ടു താവഴിയായി കാട്ടാർക്കും, തുണത്തുകടവിലേയ്ക്കും, കാട്ടാർനിന്ന് ഇടത്തൂരുത്തിയിലേയ്ക്കും വ്യാപിച്ചു. ഈ പുസ്തകത്തിന്റെ രണ്ടാം ഭാഗം മേൽപ്പറഞ്ഞ പാർട്ടി ശാഖയുടെ ചരിത്രമാണ്.

രേഖപ്പെടുത്തപ്പെട്ടിട്ടുള്ള രണ്ടാമത്തെ സ്ഥലമാറ്റം മത്തായി മകൻ കുഞ്ഞിപ്പറമ്പ് ആലക്കോട്ട് കണ്ണമ്പുഴ വർക്കിയുടെ മകൾ റോസമ്മയെ കല്യാണം കഴിച്ച് 1825ൽ എത്തൻപിറ താമസമാക്കിയതാണ്. ഈ എത്തൻപിറ ശാഖയുടെ ചരിത്രം പുസ്തകത്തിന്റെ മൂന്നാം ഭാഗമായി രേഖപ്പെടുത്തിയിരിക്കുന്നു.

ചുരുക്കം ചില സ്ഥലമാറ്റങ്ങൾ കൂടി ഉണ്ടായിട്ടുണ്ട്. പക്ഷെ അതിൽ ബന്ധപ്പെട്ടവരുടെ അപഗ്രസംഭരണയുടെ പരിധിയിൽ കണക്കാക്കപ്പെട്ടത് അവരുടെ ചരിത്രവും മുഴിക്കുളം ശാഖയുടെ ഉൾപ്പെടുത്തി ഒന്നാം ഭാഗത്തിൽത്തന്നെയാണ് രേഖപ്പെടുത്തിയിരിക്കുന്നത്.

PART - 1 MOOZHIKULAM BRANCH

Located on the banks of Chalakudy river at a distance of about 20 Km. north west of Kalady, the birth place of Sankaracharya, Moozhikulam was such a reputed and ancient seat of vedic studies that it earned the holy name of 'Thiru Moozhikulam'. Availability of plenty of fresh water attracted many rich and aristocratic families to settle down in this holy place. Seasonal floods of the river brought with it adequate natural manure for cultivation; but the floods occasionally played havoc with the lives of the inhabitants.

The mega flood of the year 1924 washed away most of the houses in Moozhikulam and flooded the ancient St. Mary's Church. The documents of the church, which would have otherwise been a sure source of information about the early history of Panikulam family, were thus mostly destroyed. The history, therefore, was constructed on the basis of the documents left over in the church, other sources, tradition and the memory of the living members.

In addition to the mention of Rev.Fr. Ittoop Panikulam who was its vicar during the 7th century A.D., references are also available in the church documents about another Rev. Fr. Panikulam to whom the title of 'Malpan' had been conferred. Rev. Fr.Korath is another member of the family whose name finds a place in the documents. But the available data are not adequate to trace back the genealogy beyond the year 1700 A.D. The history, therefore has been recorded with Mr. Kunjuvareed, whose year of birth falls around this year, as the single member of the 1st generation in Moozhikulam.

It is pertinent to note that the strength of the family units has increased from 1 to over 200 within about 300 years of its recorded existence from 1,700 A.D. At the same rate of increase the proliferation should have been from one to at least 8 lacs units between 700 and 1700 A.D, which certainly did not happen. These figures conclusively prove that the rate of population growth in general and of the family during the earlier days was substantially lower than those recorded in the later periods. It is also possible that the family had adopted an order of inheritance which envisaged vesting of exclusive rights for transfer of the family title and properties on the first male member of each generation until the system changed, probably in the later part of the 17th century, by the influence of the western culture. If the above assumption is true, the strength of the family in the year 1700 could have been even limited to one member, namely, Mr. Kunjuvareed.

GENERATION - I

Kunjuvareed continued to live in his ancestral house in the Elavoor Kunnappillyssery region or Moozhikulam Parish. He had two sons.

GENERATION - II

The sons of Kunjuvareed (I) were Joseph (II.1) and Cheria (II.2).

II-1 : Joseph moved out from Moozhikulam and settled in North Parur and thus the Parur Branch of Panikulam family was formed. The history of this branch has been recorded as part - II of this book.

II.2 Cheria continued to live in his ancestral house. He had three sons.

GENERATION - III

The sons of Cheria II.2 were Varky (III.1), Mathai (III.2) and Chacku (III.3)

III.1 Varky Settled down near his ancestral house. He had one son

III.2 Mathai also settled near his ancestral house. He had 2 sons and 1 daughter.

III.3 Chacku continued to live in his ancestral house. He had 2 sons.

GENERATION - IV

Cheriano (IV.1) was the son of Varky (III.1)

IV.1 Cheriano continued to live in his ancestral house. He had 2 sons.

The children of Mathai (III.2) were Chacku (IV.2), Kunjicheria (IV.3) and Mariam (IV.4)

IV.2 Chacku settled down in his ancestral house. He had 5 sons.

IV.3 Kunjicheria married Rosamma, D/o. Mr. Varky Alakkat Kannampuzha, Puthenchira and settled in Puthenchira. The history of the thus formed Puthenchira branch has been recorded in part - 3 of the book.

OUSEPH [SHIFTED TO PARUR FROM MOOZHICKULAM]

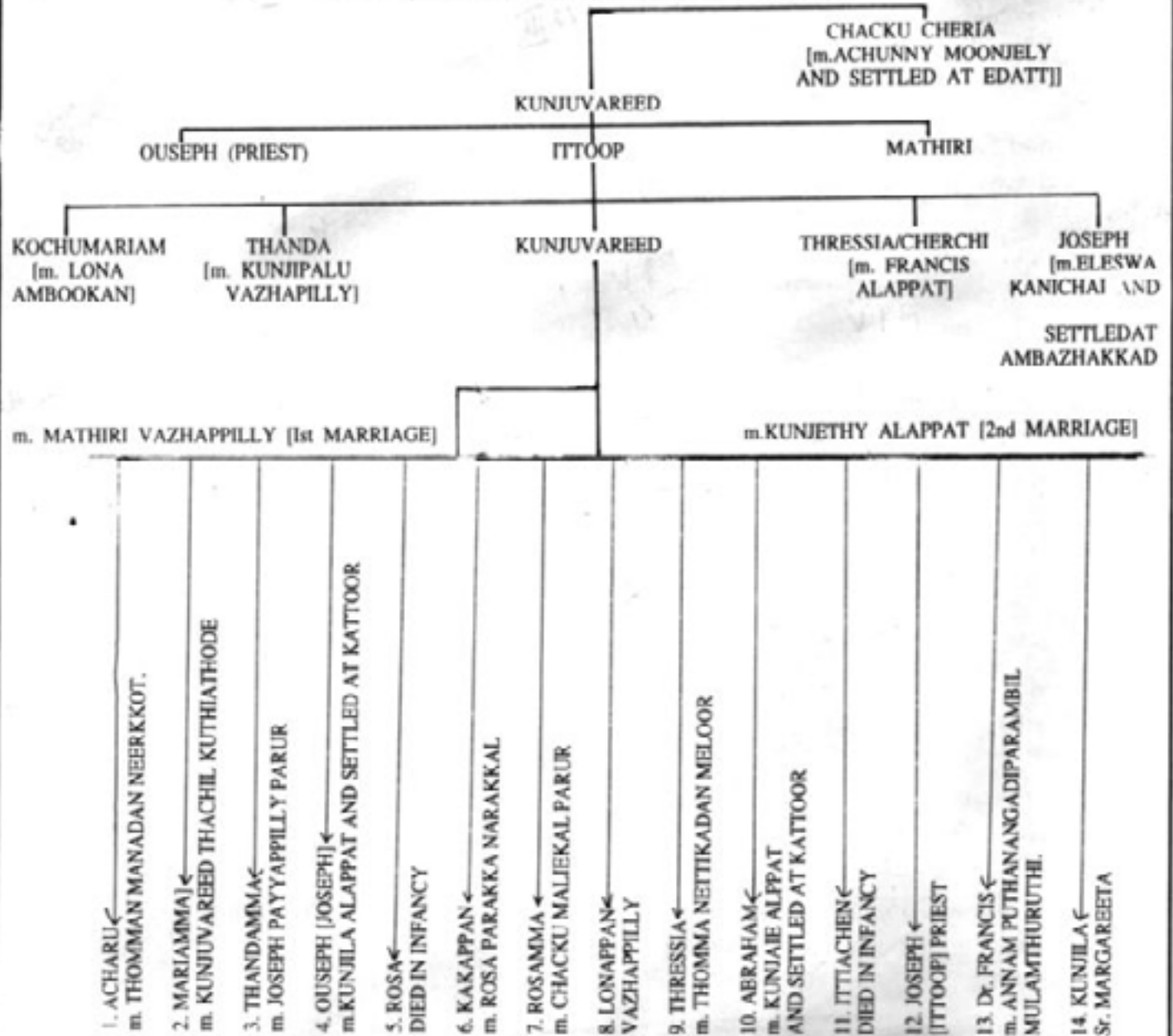

EARLY HISTORY - PARUR BRANCH

The Panikulam family has a tradition, attached to its establishment at North Parur in the former Travancore State. Joseph a member of the ancient Panikulam stock at Moozhikulam fell out with the local 'Naduvazhi' and shifted to North Parur in the year 1750. He bought a plot of land at Pazhayangadi and built his new home there. This house gave rise to another family name "Puthenveetil". Later on, Joseph sold this property and bought another in the south where he made his house. Since then this family has come to be known as "Thekkeputhenveedu". The branches of the Panikulam family have now spread over to Ambazhakad (Vyathala) Kattoor, and many other places.

Joseph had two sons Kunjuvareed and Chackuncheria. Kunjuvareed lived at the Parur home and had two sons Joseph and Ittoop and a daughter Mathiri.

Chackuncheria married Achunni, the only daughter of Tharian of Moonjely family, Angamaly. He was adopted into that family and he is the founder of the Edat branch of Panikulam family which is now known as Moonjely family.

Joseph the 2nd son of Kunjuvareed, became a priest and was the vicar for very many years in his own parish church of Parur and later of Moozhikulam church where he passed away in the year 1853 at the age of 58.

His brother, Ittoop, who lived in the family home married Acharu, D/o. Joseph Elamkunnappusha, Parur and had two sons and three daughters-Kochumariam, Thanda, Kunjuvareed, Thressia and Joseph.

Ittoop, the second son of Kunjuvareed, was of a gentle and benevolent disposition, ever ready to help others. He died in the year 1870 at the age of 61.

Mathiri, the daughter of Kunjuvareed, was married to Cherianio of Thadikkaran family, Moozhikulam.

Ittoop's daughter, Kochumariam was married to Lona of Ambookan family Poyya. The second daughter, Thanda, was married to Kunjipalu of Vazhappilly family Puthenvelikkara and the third daughter, Theressia (Cherchi), to Francis of Alappat family, Karanchira.

Ittoop's eldest son, Kunjuvareed, was born in the year 1835. He married Mathiri the daughter of Kunjuvareed Vazhappilly and had five children-Acharu, Mariam, Thandamma, Joseph (Papu) and Rosa (died in infancy). Mathiri died at the age of 24 and then Kunju

vareed married Kunjethi, daughter of Kakkappan Alappat, Karanchira and had nine children- Kakkappan, Rosamma, Lonappan, Thressia, Abraham (Kunjuvara), Ittiachen (died in infancy), Ittoop (Joseph), Francis and Kunjila. Out of the two marriages Kunjuvareed had fourteen children.

Kunjuvareed was an ideal father. He was deeply religious. He realised the value education and gave his children the best possible education. His wife Kunjethi was an efficient mother who loved and looked after the children of her husband in the first marriage as well as her own children. She died in 1898 at the age of 50. Kunjuvareed died in 1903 at the age of 60.

Ittoop's second son, Joseph (brother of Kunjuvareed) married Eleswa, daughter of Ittoop of Chakkalamattathu-Kanichai family, Ambazhakkad (Vynthala). Since Eleswa had no brothers, her husband Joseph, lived with her at her home and this gave rise to the Ambazhakkad branch of the Panikulam family.

Acharu, the eldest daughter of Kunjuvareed, was married to Thomman of Manadan family, Neerkot; the second daughter, Mariamma to Kunjuvareed, son of Ittoop of Thachil family Kuthiathode; the third daughter, Thandamma, to Joseph, son of Varkey of Payyappilly family, north Parur. Kunjuvareed's daughter Rosamma (in his second marriage) was married to Chacko son of Ittoop Maliekkal; Thressia to Thomman, son of Kunjuvareed of Nettikadan family, Meloor and Kunjila became a nun (Sr. Margarete).

Joseph (Pappu), the eldest son of Kunjuvareed, married Kunjila, daughter of Kunjipalu of Alappat family, Kattoor and settled at Kattoor and originated the first branch of the Panikulam family at Kattoor.

Kakkappan, the second son, married Rosa, daughter of Thomas of Parakkal family, Narakkal and Lonappan, the third son, Married Elacharu, daughter of Devassy of Vazhappilly family. Kakkappan and Lonappan settled at Parur.

Kunjuvareed's fourth son, Kunjavara (Abraham) married Kunjaie, daughter of Poulouse of Alappat family Kattoor. since Kunjaie had no brother he also settled at Kattoor and originated the second branch of the Panikulam family at Kattoor.

Kunjuvareed's fifth son, Joseph (Ittoop), became a priest and served at various churches of the Ernakulam Archdiocese.

Kunjuvareed's youngest son, Francis, married Annamma daughter of Lona Puthenangadiparambil, Mulamthuruth, and after serving in the Army and the Madras Medical service, settled at Parur.

PARUR SUB BRANCH

Kakkappan the second son of Kunjuvareed (the eldest in the second marriage) married Rosa, daughter of Thoma and Kunjila of Parakkal family, Narakkal. He had four sons and six daughters : Kunjuvareed, Kunjila (died in infancy) Kunjila, Kunjathi, Thoman, Joseph (Kochappu) Mariamkutty, Ittop (Joseph), Thresiakutty and Brijitha. A few years after his marriage Kakkappan built a house for himself at Kalarikkaparambil and shifted his family to that new house. Kakkappan was the 'Karanavar' of the numerous branches of Panikulam family at the time of publication of the 1st edition of the Panikulam family history. Kakkappan expired at the age of 75 in 1943 and his wife Rosa expired at the age of 94 in 1960.

Kunjila the eldest daughter of Kakkappan was married to Poulouse, daughter of Vareed and Mathiri of Petta family, Varapuzha, Kunjathi was married to Geevarghese, son of Kurian and Acharu of Kachappilly family, Chakkarakadavu, Mariamkutty is married to Joseph B.A., son of Pavunny and Eliya of Thattil Nadakkalan family, Peringottukara, Thressia is married to Varkey, son of Mathai and Mariam of Valiarambathu family, Vaikom and the youngest Brigitha is married to Kunjipalu M.B.B.S., son of Chakku and Kunjila of Thottungal family Kandasankadavu. Thresia Varkey died on 15-1-90.

Kakkappan's eldest son Varghese B.A.B.L. (Kunjuvareed) married Mariam, daughter of Poulouse and Naithi of Attokkaran family, Trichur. He had been practising as an advocate for some years at Parur District Court and Malabar District Court. Afterwards he shifted his family to Trichur and settled there. He expired on 23rd April 1984 at the age of 93. Varghese has a son and two daughters, Paul (Baby), Ammini and Chinnamma. Ammini is married to C.J. George, B.Sc. (Hons.) son of Ouseph and Kunjaram of Chalissery family Edathuruthy. Mr. George retired as Assistant Director Meteriology Department. Chinnamma is married to C.K. John B.A.B.L. son of Kuriakose of Chemmannur family, Palayoor. Mr. John retired as Joint Secretary to Government.

Paul (Baby) the only son of Varghese married Annie, daughter of Devassy of Chakkola family, Trichur. He took his Diploma in Electrical Engineering and permanently settled at Trichur. Now he is doing business at Trichur. He has two sons and six daughters. Reema B.Sc. (IInd rank in Home Science), Varghese, Geena, Rose David B.Sc., Mary B.A., Femy and Julie. Reema, the eldest daughter of Paul is married to Joy B.Sc. (Officer in Kuwait Bank) son of Thomas Chiriyankandath, Ernakulam. Geena is married to Joseph B.E., son of P.J. Francis (I.A.S.) Palayoor House, Ollur. He is working as an engineer in Saudi Arabia. Rose is married to Vincy, son of A.D. Kuriakose of Arakkal family in

Kakkappan's second son Thomas (Thoman) married Annamma daughter of Kunjuvareed and Rosa of Pynadath family of Karukkutty. After completing his education he was appointed as the Manager of the Parur Bank and retired while he was working as Manager of Catholic Union Bank. He expired on 22nd October 1982 at the age of 82.

He has five sons and six daughters, Lucy, Thankamma, Jacob (Kakkappan) Lilly and Daisy (twins), Varghese, Joseph, Alice, Johny, Cicily and Joy.

Lucy, the eldest daughter of Thomas is married to Mathew son of Lonakunji of Ayinikkal family, Kundoor. He retired from Central Government service. Thankamma is married to Devassykutty, son of Kunjipoulo of Maliakkal family, Puthenchira. He is working as an adviser in S.C. Brothers, Bombay. Daisy and Lilly (twins) entered the "Medical Mission Sisters" and took the names as Sr. Lucia Panikulam and Sr. Agnas Panikulam respectively. Sr. Lucia Panikulam, B. Pharm, M.H.A. (Daisy) took her B.Pharm, from Gujarat University and Master's Degree in Hospital Administration from the University of Philippines. After her education she worked as administrator at various hospitals in India. At present she is holding the post of Director Holy Family Hospital in New Delhi.

Sr. Agnes Panikulam B.Com. M.S.S.I.R.D. (Lilly) took her Batchelor's degree in Commerce and Master's Degree in Social Science specialising in Integral Rural Development. After her education she had been working as administrator of Holy Family Hospital in Mandar for eight years. She is one of the governing board members of Archdiocese of Ranchi. Now she is working in California.

The third daughter Alice, is married to Jose, son of Kunjuvareed of Ukken family, Kalparambu. He is working as Shipping Manager in a French Firm at Singapore. Cicily the youngest daughter of Thomas is married to George B.Sc. B.Ed., son of Joseph of Vennattuparambil, Pariyaram. He is working as a teacher in Kuttikad High School.

Kunjalakutty expired on 19-5-89 at the age of 79.

Rose the eldest daughter of Joseph is married to Dr. Antony, M.S.F.F., A.R.C.S., son of Sebastian Manavalan, Trichur. He is practising in Malasia. Mary is married to Dr. George Joseph, M.D., son of Joseph Vettamveli, Vallakam, Vaikom. Dr. George Joseph is now practising in U.S.A. Teresa the youngest daughter of Joseph is married to Mr. Simon B.E. son of Kunjuvareed, Kodankandath, Manaloor. He is doing business at Kalamassery.

Dr. Jacob B.Sc. M.B.B.S., D.P.H., the only son of Dr. Joseph married Rita, daughter of Late Professor Paul Alappatt, Karanchira. He has two children Joseph and Elizabeth. Dr. Jacob is in the Malasian Medical Service since 1962. For services rendered he was awarded P.P.N.P from the State of Perlis, B.S.K. from the State of Kelantan and A.M.P. from the State of Pahang. Representing Malasian Medical Service he has visited the countries like United Kingdom, Europe, U.S.A., and Far East countries in the course of his public health administration. He was holding the post of Deputy Director of Medical Health Service, Pahang State. Presently he is in Brunei.

The fourth son of Kakkappan, Very Rev. Msgr. Joseph Panikulam, after his secondary education joined the Minor Seminary at Enakulam in 1925. In 1930 he was selected by the

Arch. Bishop to continue his studies in Rome. Thus he joined Propaganda College in Rome. When he was a Bachelor of Divinity in Theology, he had the opportunity to study in the faculty of Missiology. He was the first student from India in this faculty. Br. Joseph was ordained as priest by His Eminence Cardinal Marksty Selvagiany at Lattaran Basilica in Rome on 23rd December 1933. He got the rare opportunity to celebrate the first Holy Mass in the Jubilee year at the St. Peter's Basilica the next day 24th December 1933. After visiting the Holy Land and holy Shrines of Lourdes, Turin, Paúva, etc. he returned to India in 1934.

He had been working as Vicar and Forane Vicar of various churches since 1936. During his parish work he has built a number of churches, School buildings and Chapels in different places. He was the Manager of about 20 schools including the General Nursing School at Angamaly.

In 1937 he had the occasion to visit the Philippines in connection with the 33rd International Eucharistic Congress as the Representative of Archdiocese, of Ernakulam. He is the founder of the Social Institute at Kalamassery and the "Women's Social Industrial Co-operative Society" at Shertally.

He was taking rest as the Chaplain of St. Joseph's Convent Neerpara and the Spiritual Adviser of the Deaf and Blind School, Assisi Mount, Neerpara. He expired on 11-8-93.

Kunjuvareed, Acharuny, Devassy, Poulouse, Joseph (died in infancy) Neithi (died when a girl), Kunjithi Kakkappan, Ittoop. Acharunny was

married to Kunjuvareed, son of Mathai and Mariam of Chakkiyath family, Thundathumkadavu. Kunjuvareed passed away before long and she was married again to Kunjuthup, son of Poulouse and Mathiri of Payyappilly family, Parur. Kunjithi was married to Itteera son of Cheriathu and Elisa of Elanjikkal family, Kuthiyathode.

Lonappan's eldest son Kunjuvareed (Varghese) married Thresia, daughter of Mathai and Mariam of Chakkiyath family, Thundathumkadavu and settled there permanently. Thus a branch of Panikulam family was established at Thundathumkadavu. Kunjuvareed expired on 14-4-1979 at the age of 84. Kunjuvareed has 3 sons and 2 daughters : Varghese, Johny, Mathai, Baby (Annamma) and Thresiamma (Gracy). Baby the eldest daughter of Kunjuvareed is married to Joseph, son of Augustine, Thekkanath House, Olanad, Varapuzha. (London) Polakkan, Changanacherry. Dr. P.V. Francis after retirement as Chief Surgeon joined West Fort Hospital, Trichur as Director.

Dr. Jacob had been in the Madras Medical Service. He retired as the Asst. Director of Medical Service, Madras and settled at Trichur.

Lonappan's fifth son Ittoop married Elizabeth, daughter of Antony of Alappatt family, Karanchira. Ittoop has two sons and one daughter Joy, Santha and Jose. Santha is married to Poly, son of Joseph, Edappilly House, Kadupassery. Ittoop expired on 12-12-91.

Joy, B.Sc. (Engg) the eldest son of Ittoop, married Jemma, daughter of Enasu of Velukkaran family, Trichur. Joy has two daughters Deepa (20) and Roupa (16) and son Tinu (7). Joy is now working in Sultanate of Oman as Chief Executive of Haifa Construction Company.

Jose, the second son of Ittoop married Betsey, daughter of Joseph Elenjikkal, Alleppy. He has a son Kiran (11) and a girl Nithin (8). Jose is working in Sultanate of Oman. Now he is Managing Partner of 'Musana Cinema.

Kunjuvareed's fifth son (or fourth from the second marriage) is well known and respected Rev. Fr. Joseph Panikulam, affectionately known as Valla Ittooppachan to his large circle of friends and admirers is one of the brightest gems the Panikulam family has ever produced.

Born on 4th May 1884, Ittooppachan went through his primary education at Elthuruth, Trichur, and Ernakulam and commenced his Sacerdotal course in 1906 at the Puthenpally Apostolic Seminary, Verapoly. He was ordained priest by Mar Louis Pazhayaparambil, Vicar Apostolic of Ernakulam, on 22nd Dec. 1912 and offered his first Mass on 30th December in the Seminary Chapel. On 8th January 1913 he offered his first Coram Pontific solemn High Mass in Kottakkavu Church (Parur) and commenced work as Assistant Vicar of his own Parish Church as well as that of south Pallipuram. Later he was appointed Vicar of the Nedungad Church with additional charge of the then locked up Narakkal Church. ON 15th August 1917, St. Mary's Festival Day, the ban on the Narakkal Church was lifted and Ittooppachan as Vicar offered mass there. Later when he was Vicar at Koratty he was able to establish the Adoration Convent of the Sacred Heart, the first in the Arch Diocese and also became the first Chaplain of this convent. From Koratty he was successively transferred to Kothamangalam, Moozhikulam, N.Parur and Vaikom Churches as Vicar as well as Chaplain of the convents attached to those churches.

While he was at N.Parur he went on a Pilgrimage with the second batch of Pilgrims from India to attend the 19th Centenary celebrations of our Saviour's crucifixion. The Pilgrims embarked from Madras on 28th February 1934. Ittooppachan, therefore had the good fortune, to visit the holy places in Palestine such as Jerusalem, Bethlehem, Nazareth, Mount Carmel and the European Holy cities of Rome, Padua, Lourdes and Lcieux as well as London, Paris, Cairo etc. He was granted an audience by the Holy Father Pope Pius XI and received his Apostolic Blessing and on his return to India visited St. Thomas Cathedral at Mylapore, Madras where he offered a Thanksgiving Mass at the shrine of St. Thomas the Apostle of India.

When he was Vicar of the Malayattoor Church he obtained from the Government 4 cents of land at the Kurisumalai Hill and erected at his own expense a splendid shrine and put up in it a beautiful statue of St. Thomas to commemorate his Sacerdotal Silver Jubilee, on Sunday 9th January, 1938. This Jubilee day was a red-letter day in the annals of the place and the ceremonies were conducted with great pomp and splendour.

The silver jubilee celebrations began with a Pontifical High Mass by Ittooppachan assisted by four priests of the Panikulam Family. In the afternoon after the Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament, the parishioners held a Meeting with Rev. Msgr. Joseph Panjikkaran in the chair to congratulate Ittoopachen.

His grace Dr. Augustine Kandathil Archbishop of Ernakulam blessed the Jubilee Commemoration shrine and statue, assisted by a large gathering of church dignitaries and priests, inclu-

ding vicar General Msgr. George Valiarampeth, Msgr. Joseph Panjikkaran and Secretary, Rev. Fr. Varghese, Pudussery. The statue was unveiled before a vast concourse of people gathered to facilitate their loving Ittoopachen.

Thereafter he became Vicar of the Kanjoor Forane Church. Generous, kind hearted and charitable, devoted to his church, his flock and his family loved and respected in return, Ittooppachen led a calm unruffled and peaceful life helping the needy and comforting the rich and sorrowstricken.

Rev. Fr. Joseph Panikulam while resting at Chowara after leading an eventful life, expired on 22-4-1952.

Francis (Porinju) 14-5-1888 Kunjuvareed's youngest son married Annamma (August 1900) daughter of Sri. Lonan and Elamma of Puthanangadiparambil family, Mulamthuruthy on 8th January 1913. It is specially noteworthy that the wedding ceremony was solemnised by his elder brother Rev.Fr. Joseph (Valia Ittooppachan) on the same day the latter said his first Coram Pontific solemn High Mass, which is a unique event. It may also be mentioned that on the Silver Jubilee of these events the first book of the History of Panikulam Family, was published entirely by the efforts of late Rev.Fr. Joseph Panikulam (Ittooppachan).

After graduation Francis went to Madras took his M.B.B.S. degree served in the last great war as a captain in the I.M.S. and was stationed at Bangalore until he was sent overseas to Salonika. After Armistice he was stationed at Constantinople for 5 years on Military Service. On his return to India he was appointed Assistant Surgeon in the General Hospital, Madras. He was fortunate to visit Rome twice and on both occasions had audience with H.H. Pope Pius XI and received his Apostolic Blessing. Dr. P.V. Francis has also visited the holy cities of Jerusalem, Bethlehem, Nazareth etc. He was in London for a year to specialise in anaesthesia and was the anaesthetist specialist and Senior assistant Surgeon in the General Hospital, Madras. He was granted the Diploma, D.A.R.C.P.S. (England) by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons. Dr. and Mrs. Annamma Francis had four sons and five daughters. Kunjuvareed (Vava), Elizabeth (Kunjamma), Mary (Ammini), Bridget Regina (Thangam), Kochu Thresia (Cherupushpam), Rose (Shantha), Joseph (died in infancy) Joseph and John.

Dr.Francis, after retirement as Civil Surgeon from Madras Medical Services settled down in N.Parur taking rest and engaged himself in various family, social and philanthropic activities. He was the founder President of the St. Vincent De-Paul, Society attached to

the St.Germaine's Church N.Parur. He was the first President of the Alwaye-Parur Branch of the Indian Medical Association. Again he was the Director and finally Chairman of the Federal Bank Ltd, for a number of years. By his congenial manners and affable disposition he endeared himself to all those with whom he came into contact. Mrs. Annamma Francis expired on 27-1-1963 at the age of 63 and Dr. Francis expired on 9th March 1970 at the age of 82.

The eldest son Dr. P.F. Varghese (Vava) 16-1-1915 married Mariamma (Mary B.A.) daughter of Dr.A.P. Kuriappan, Alappat, Trichur on 21-1-1946. Dr. Varghese like his father joined the Army and served in the second world war overseas as captain. On his return he joined the Indian Medical Service and was appointed Assistant Surgeon in various Hospitals in Madras State. Later he also took Diploma in anaesthesia (D.A) from Madras and was working as Civil Surgeon, anaesthetist, Madras Medical Services, General Hospital, Madras, Dr. Varghese has two sons and one daughter. Lt Com. P.V. Francis (Jimmy) 20-2-1947, Indian Navy, passed out from National Defence Academy (NDA) Khadakvasala, Poona. He holds a Post Graduate Diploma in strategic studies. He married Thresiamma B.Sc. daughter of Mr. Thottungal M. Francis, Kandasankadavu and has two children, Varghese (30-4-77) and Ann Mary (6-5-1978).

Sunny, (Dr. P.V. Kurian) M.B.B.S. (9-10-1948) second son of Dr. P.V. Varghese is doing Private Practice in Madras. He married Rita, B.A., daughter of Prof. E.M. Joseph, Trivandrum and they have a son Vivek aged 16.

Dr. P.V. Varghese's daughter Mini (Dr. Annie Varghese, M.D.) is married to Dr. Joseph M.Chcrian, M.d., FRCP. AB, son of Prof.C.C. Ouseph of Angamaly. They are both working in Milton, Florida, U.S.A. and have a daughter and a son.

Dr. P.V. Varghese (Vava) after retirement settled down in Madras. He expired on 13th March 1986 at the age of 71. His wife Mrs. Mary Varghese passed away on 6th May, 1986.

Dr. Francis's second son Joseph (Dr. Joseph F.Panikulam 19-1-1935) passed Civil Engineering from Trivandrum and joined Kerala P.W.D. as Junior Engineer. Then he got a scholarship and went to Montreal, Canada took PH.D. & thereafter went to New Jersey, U.S.A. and worked in a couple of American Building Products companies in their Research and Development Departments.

He married Daisy, daughter of Mr.C.O. Antony and Achai, Chirakkakkaran House, Trichur

on 27-12-1957. They have two sons and one daughter. Franco, F.J. Panikulam (5-11-1958) Anjo (died in infancy) and Ann Elizabeth 5-6-1974. Franco 35, passed M.B.A. and Accountancy from U.S.A. and is at present working in Firestone Tyre and Rubber Company at their Plant in Spain. He married Anita daughter of Dr. Jacob Kannampilly.

Dr. Joseph F. Panikulam while employed in H.H. Robertson Company, Pittsburgh expired at his residence on 12th October 1985 and the funeral took place there.

Dr. Francis youngest son, John (P.John Francis M.A. LB. 2-8-1936) now residing at Ernakulam is working as Manager in the Sales Office of M/s Premier Tyre Ltd. Cochin. He married Mariamma (Mary) daughter of Mr.C.O. Chakkappan & Agnes, Chirakkekaran House, Trichur on 11-5-1964. They have a son Frank, 8-1-1970. John died on 16-5-93 at the age of 56. Frank passed B.D.S. and is practicing at Ernakulam. Daughter Neena Passed B.Sc (Home Science) in 1st class and got married to Paul. T. Kunnath, Trichur - 5, on 12-9-93.

Dr.Francis's eldest daughter Kunjamma is married to Mr. George Thomas, M.A.,I.A.S., son of Mr. George Thomas, Pallivathukal, Kanjirappally on 22nd January 1940. Mr. George Thomas (Tom) got into I.A.S. and retired as Chief Secretary, Govt. of Kerala. They are at present residing in Trivandrum. The second daughter Ammini is married to Antony E. Mampilly (Anthonikutty) Dentist, son of Dr. Ephrem Mampilly on 29th December 1941. A.E.Mampilly retired as Lt. Col. in the Indian Army (ADC) and settled down in Bangalore. Ouseph (Joseph) 2nd son of Ittoop from North Parur married Elieswa D/o Ittoop and Annam of Chakkalamattathu Kanichayi family, Ambazhakad (Vynthala). Since Elieswa had no brother her husband Ouseph lived with her at Vynthala and the descendants of their two sons Ittoop and Kunjuvareed formed the Ambazhakad branch of Panikulam family. The other two sons became priests. Ouseph had five sons and seven daughters-Katherine (died in infancy), Thresia, Ittoop, Kunjannam (died in infancy), Mariamma, Louis (died in infancy), Cruz, Rosamma, Kunjuvareed, Kochumariam (died young), Thomas and Kochukunjannam (died in infancy). Ouseph was deeply religious, gentle and kind-hearted. He took an active interest in public affairs especially in the sphere of education and social improvement of his countrymen. He passed away on the 10th July 1906 at the General Hospital, Ernakulam, in his 62 year and was buried at Ambazhakad with great pomp. Elieswa was also deeply religious and kind-hearted. She died on 6th December 1921 in her 72nd year.

Among Ouseph's children Theresia was married to Paulose, S/o Thoma and Cherchi of Kannampilly family, Pariaram, on 19th February 1884. She passed away on 5th August 1911. Next daughter Mariamma was born on the 29th March 1877; joined the Carmelite Convent on 10th January 1898, assumed the name Seraphine and took her perpetual vows on 24th May 1900. She became the Mother Superior of Ambazhakad Asramam. She was a Senior Member of the Managing Committee of Carmelite Convents in the Trichur Diocese. Next daughter Rosamma was born on 16th May 1885; she also joined the Carmelite order on the 4th November 1904, took the name Helena and made her final vows on 2nd April 1907. She was Mother Superior of the Ollur Convent, the Trichur Sacred Hearts Convent, and the Pavaratty Convent.

Joseph, the eldest son of Kunjuvareed and grandson of Ittoop of the main family at Parur, married Kunjila, d/o Kunjipaloo and Kunjaram of Alappatt family and settled at Kattoor. After marriage he joined the English High School at Calicut for higher education. However, he could not complete it. He was recalled home due to the ill health of his father-in-law who insisted upon Joseph to remain with him and look after the family affairs. Kattoor was very backward in education at that time. Many people visited Joseph just to hear him read and speak English. Joseph decided to dedicate himself for the development of Kattoor village and he very much succeeded in his aim. It can be said that he was the architect of modern Kattoor. He was deeply religious and philanthropic and a lover of education. He sowed the seed of Pompei St. Mary's School.

His wife, Kunjila, passed away on 12-3-1916 and he followed her on 17-9-1922 at the age of 59. He had four sons and four daughters, Kunjipaloo, George, Joseph, Thressia, Kunjaram, Kakkappan, Mathiri and Kunjethy (died in infancy).

Kunjipaloo, the eldest son, married Kunjalachi, D/o Francis of Thadikaran family, Edathuruthy and had nine sons and five daughters-Francis, Poulouse, Kochouseph, Kathreena, George, Anthony, Kunjilakutty, Mariamma, Kurian (died in Infancy), Thressia, Louis, Ittoop (died in infancy), Ruby and John. Being the eldest son, Kunjipaloo remained at home helping his father in the management of his farms and public affairs. Credit goes to him for the erection of a huge three storied building of Pompei St. Mary's High School at Kattoor. He gave his children the best possible education that several of them became university degree holders. Kunjipaloo died on 25-1-49 at the age of 68 and his wife Kunjalchi died on 8-9-1946 at the age of 65.

It was by his strenuous efforts that an inpatient ward and operation theatre were added to the Kattoor govt. dispensary and a huge building put up to house all govt. offices at Kattoor. He was deeply religious and a founder member of St. Vincent De Paul Society. He married Kunjalichy, daughter of Thadikaran Kunjuvareed and Kochumariam, Edathuruthy and settled at Edathuruthy, Kunjalichy being the only daughter. They had six sons, George (died at the age of 13), Jose, Peter, Paul, Jose (all died in infancy) and Jose (now 45 years old) and five daughters, Mary, Thressia, Baby, Lilly and Rosey. Kakkappen died on 6-2-1946 at the age of 50. Kunjalichy died on 13-3-90 at the age of 87.

Kakkappen's son, Joseph 53 discontinued studies after Pre-degree and married Marykutty (now 49 years old), D/o. Advocate Jacob Elanjikkal, Alleppey.

Kakkappen's daughter Mary was married to Dr. T.J. Job, D.Sc. Putharikal Thirrapilly Ernakulam who retired from UNO-FAO as Regional Fishery Officer and settled at Bangalore. He died in 1980 at the age of 70. Mary died on 4-8-93. Mrs. Mary Job died on 4th August, 93 aged 71 years.

Kakkappen's second daughter, Thressia, passed B.E. and joined Cochin P.W.D. Due to

her earnest, honest, dedicated service she got quick promotions and became the Chief Engineer (General) at the age of 47. She was the first lady in Asia to become a Chief Engineer. She died on 18-11-1981 at the age of 57. Kakkappen's third daughter, was married to George Manayathara (Alwaye) who retired from the Indian Army as Lieut Colonel and is settled at Ernakulam. Kakkappen's other daughters Lilly and Rosey are unmarried. Baby George died on 8-9-94. Miss Lilly died on 17-5-94.

Joseph's eldest daughter, Thressia, entered Carmelite Convent and assumed the name, Francisca and took her vow in 1913. For 25 years she worked as a teacher in Convent Schools and became Mother Superior for some years and died on July 4th 1952 at Manaloor Convent at the age of 61. Joseph's second daughter, Kunjaram also joined the Carmelite Convent and took her vow in 1916 and assumed the name, Bertha. She passed Drawing Higher Grade and worked as Drawing Teacher for 22 years at Irinjalakuda LFCGHS. She died at Irinjalakuda Convent on 18-8-1953 at the age of 58. Joseph's youngest daughter Mathiri, was married to Advocate Paul Mampilly, B.A.B.L. (Narakkel) who later on became a High Court Judge. She died of Tetanus in 1936 at the age 34 and her husband in 1953 at the age of 59.

Kunjavara (Abraham) (25-11-1058), fourth son of Ittoop Kunjuvarced Panikulam of Parur, married Kunjal (25-11-1059), D/o Poulouse and Rosa Alappat of Kattoor on 17-4-1899 and they settled down in Kattoor. Thus a second branch of Panikulam family of Parur came into existence at Kattoor.

Abraham worked very hard to improve the village in all directions. It was due to his efforts that the village Panchayat and Co-operative Society were established at Kattoor. He was the president of these institutions and also manager of the local school which he brought to the level of a full fledged Lower Secondary English School. He can also be said to be the founder of modern Kattoor. In appreciation of his services the public of Kattoor put up his photo in the school and the same was unveiled by the then Diwan of Cochin Sri. Vijayaraghavachariar.

Abraham had 3 sons and 5 daughters Mariam (died in infancy) Poulouse (6-1-1079), George

(11-8-1080), Kunjethy (11-11-1083), Joseph (7-3-1086), Rosa (22-4-1089), Mariam (5-11-1091) and Thressia (2-2-1098).

Kunjethy was married to Maliamavu Mathew Lona, Proprietor, Bharatha Vilasam Press, Trichur on 11-11-1926. Rosa was married to Chakkunny, T.T.I. Southern Railway S/o Pazhayattil Kunjuvareed, Puthenchira on 11-9-1933. Mary was married to Thomas of Revenue Department S/o Edakalathur Kuriakose of Chawakkad on 7-2-1936. Thressia was married to Kochappu S/o Tharayil Kochouseph of Malayattoor on 27-11-1939. He is an agriculturist. Abraham's daughter Kunjethi died on 18-6-1988 at the age of 88.

Abraham's eldest son Pouluse, passed L.M.P. and worked as Honorary doctor at Civil Hospital Trichur and then for many years as in charge of the Government Dispensary at Anthikad as Honorary Sub-Assistant Surgeon. He married Annamma D/o Alappat Aypunny and Plemenra of Kattoor on 24-5-1931.

Dr. Pouluse had 3 daughters and one son-Leela (2-5-1935), Gracy (5-6-1938) Ammini (12-6-1942) and Jose (9-3-1946). Leela was married to P.O. Thomas M.A. I.R.S. who retired as Asst. Collector of Customs Son of Paddathiparambil Ouseph of Trichur on 6-1-1958. Gracy was married to Kakkappan J, Alappat, B.Sc son of Joseph Alappatt, Karanchira, General Manager South Indian Bank Ltd., Trichur on 14-11-1960. Ammini B.Sc., B.Ed. was married to A.J. Paul M.A., L.L.B., former Principal, Education Department, Nigeria and son of Jacob Arakal of Pavaratty on 10-11-1964. Ammini has worked as High School teacher at Nigeria. They have now settled down at Pavartty.

Jose became a doctor and married Santha daughter of Chirayath Inasu and Kunjethy of Trichur on 27-8-1972. They have a daughter Jiffy (14-3-74) and a son Paul (20-12-76). Jose expired at the age of 35. Jose's Daughter Jiffy married Joe Moyalan.

Mr. George, second son Abraham was the Head Master at Government School Kattoor. He married Rosa daughter of Attokkaran Anthonykutty and Mathiri of Trichur on 14-1-29. He died on 27-4-61 at the age 56. He has 4 sons and 3 daughters Abraham (22-5-1930), Mathew and Mercy (27-3-1934), Antony (26-3-1939), Kochuthressia (23-5-1942) Jose (25-3-1948) and Jessy (31-12-1949).

Abraham the eldest son of George is Manager Jose Theatre Trichur and a Partner of Metro soda Factory Trichur. He married Reetha, daughter of Chungath Joseph & Achai, Aranattukara on 30-5-1960. His only son, Thomas was born on 5-4-1969. He has settled down at Trichur.

Mathew the second son, took B.A. degree and he is the Chief Superintendent, South Indian Bank, Regional Office, Coimbatore. He married Valsa, daughter of Chowollur Varu and Kochumariam on 16-2-1966. He was the Secretary, Officers Association, South Indian Bank and is an active member of Lions Club Coimbatore. He has 4 daughters Rinsie (6-1-1967) Maksie (12-5-1968) Ansie (3-9-1983) and Priya (29-1-1978). Mathew's eldest daughter Rinsie married Mr. Jos John s/o T.A. 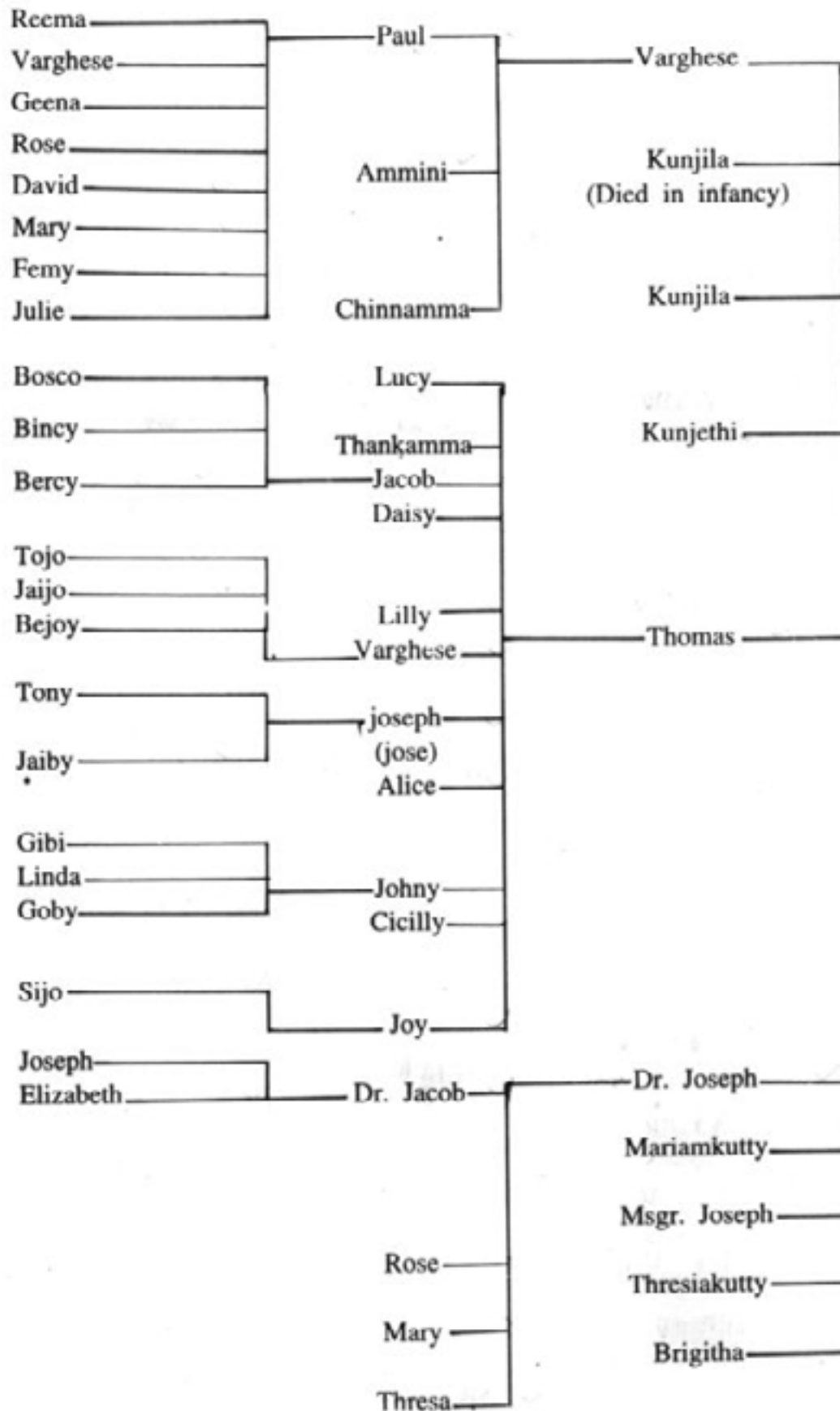

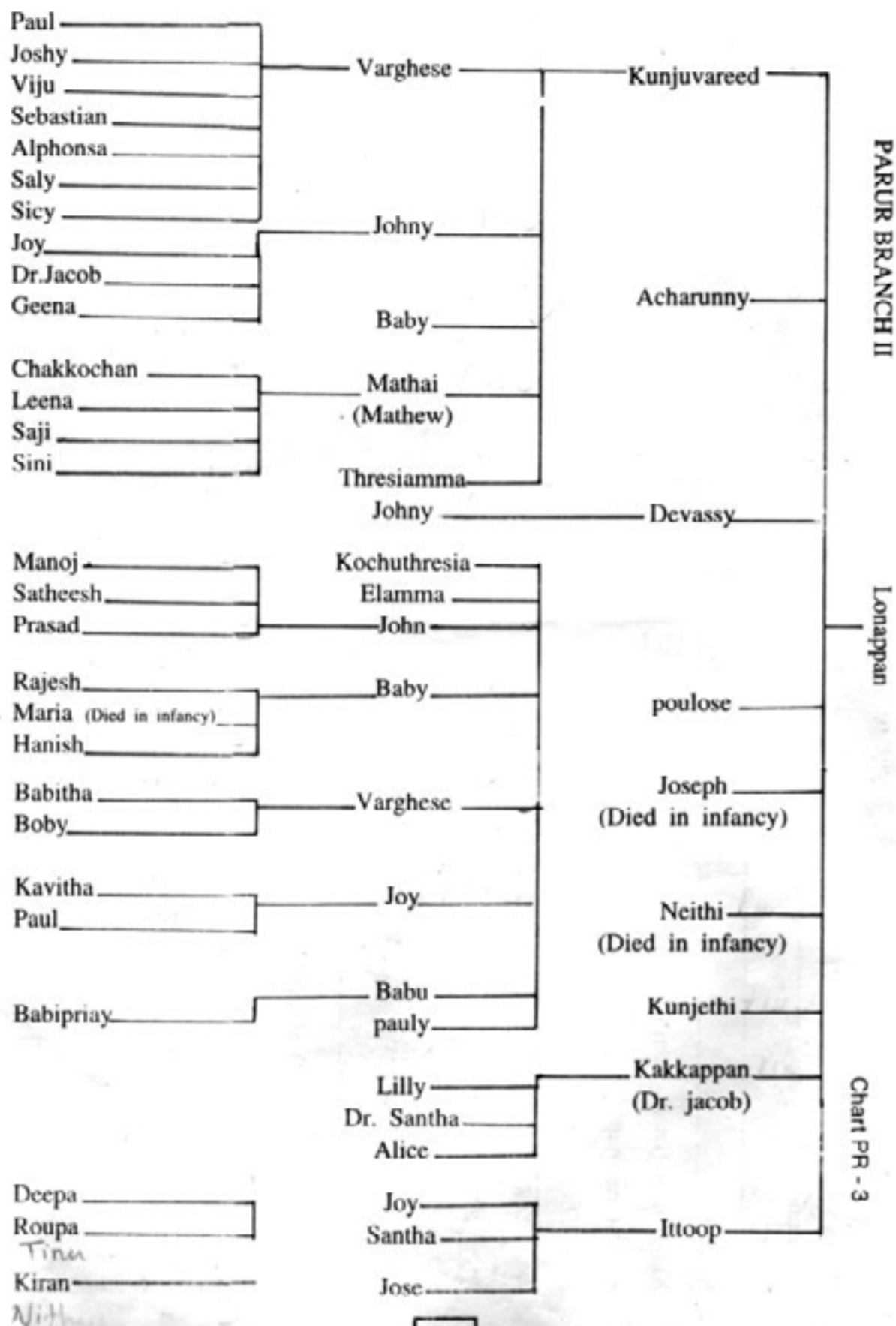

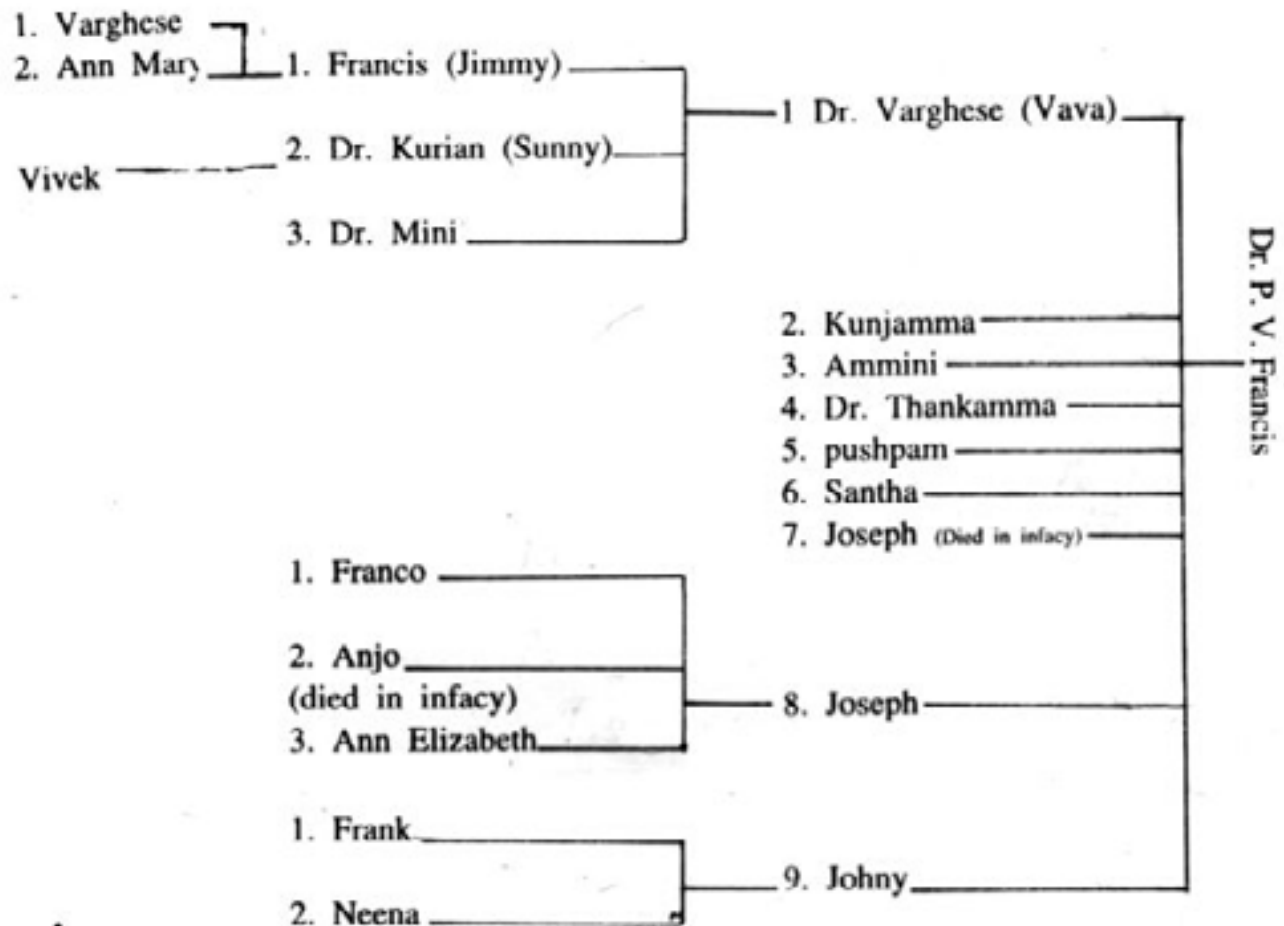

(Second son of Ittoop from North Parur who Came to Ambazhakad)

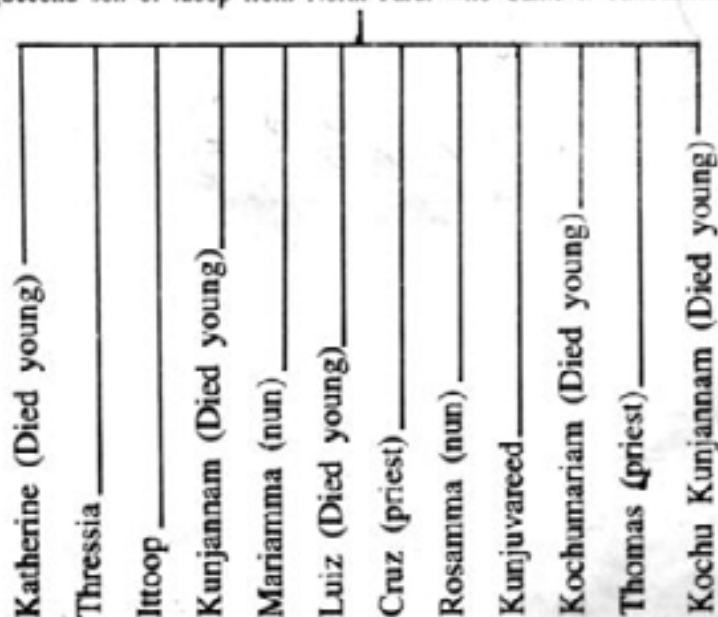
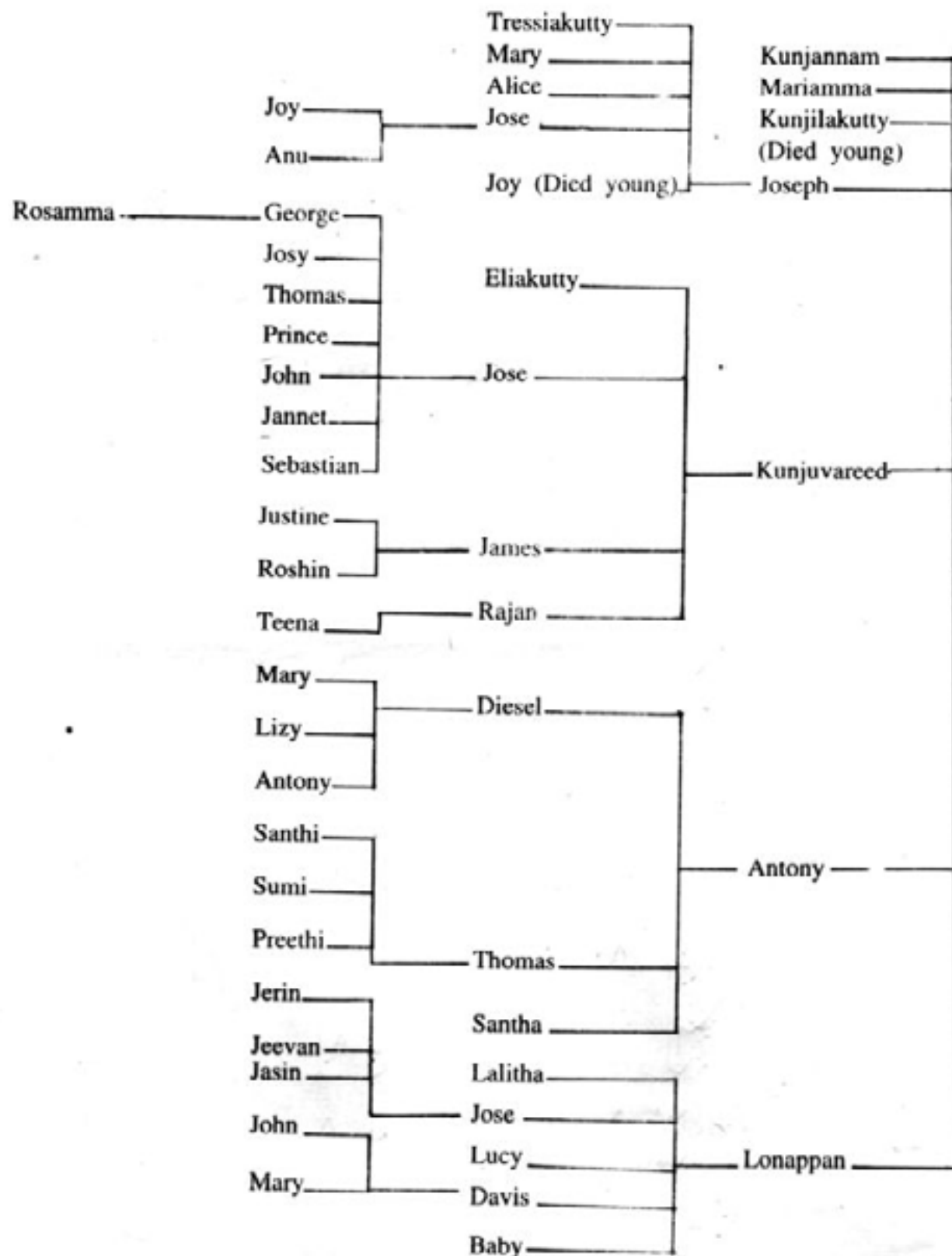

PART III PUTHENCHIRA BRANCH

Situated at a distance of about 12 K.M. South of Irinjalakuda and about 12 KM. west of Chalakudy in Trichur Dt. the picturesque village of Puthenchira was a prosperous trading centre till the early part of the 18th century A.D. The Maharaja of Cochin gifted the village as a token of his gratitude to the Maharaja of Travancore for his assistance in defending the kingdom of Cochin when it was invaded by the then Zamorin of Calicut in the year 1858 A.D. Surrounded on all sides by the kingdom of Cochin, and thus isolated from the rest of Travancore, the villagers had a difficult life during times of war or peace until it became a part of the Travancore Cochin State in the year 1957 A.D.

Puthenchira was a strong base for Syrian Catholics right from the 16th century A.D. Alakkat Kannampuzha was one of Aristocratic and rich families dominating the scene during the 19th century A.D. The history of Panikulam family in Puthenchira begins with the marriage of Rossamma, the eldest daughter of Varky Alakkat Kannampuzha by Kunjicheria, son of Mr. Mathai, Panikulam, Moozhikulam in 1825. Since Mr. Kunjuvarky did not have sons, Kunjicheria inherited part of his properties, built a house in the 'Angadi' proper and settled down in Puthenchira.

PUTHENCHIRA BRANCH

GENERATION - 1

Kunjicheria (1800-1876) (I.1) had one son and a daughter

GENERATION II

Kunjuvarkey (II.1) and Achar (II.2) were the children of Kunjicheria

II.1 Kunjuvarky (1826-1914) married Mariam D/o Mr. Thomas Maliekal Koonan, Puthenchira and continued to live in the ancestral house. He had 3 sons and 2 daughters

II.2 Achar, the daughter of Kunjicheria was married to Ittira, Maliekal Koonan Puthenchira.

GENERATION III

The children of Kunjuvarky (II.1) were Thoman (III.1) Mathai (III.2), Kunjicheria (III.3) Rosamma (III.4) and Kunjelia (III.5)

- III.1 Thoman (1864-1918) became a diocesan priest and rendered meritorious service as vicar of different churches
- III.2 Mathai (1866-1940) married Rosa D/o. Thoman Manjooran, Chakarakadavu. Mathai was a renowned arbitrator in respect of partition of properties. His impartiality and expertise were accepted & acknowledged far and wide and he had earned laurels even from different principalities for his assistance and contribution in the field. The presentation of a gold bangle and a silk shawl by the Tripunithura palace in this connection deserves special mention. He moved out of his ancestral house and settled near the eastern border of the village where the family had substantial real estate. Mathai had 7 sons and 2 daughters.
- III.2 Kunjicheria (1869-1949) married Kunjai, the daughter of Devassy Kattukkaran Ollur and continued to live in the 'Tharavadu'. He enlarged the house substantially for it to earn the name 'Valiapura' of Puthenchira. He was a well known trader and his merchandise included spices, tobacco and provisions. Kunjicheria had 4 sons and 2 daughters.
- III.4 Rosamma was married to Mr. Kuruvilla Sankurikal, Njarakal.
- III.5 Kunjelia was married to Mr. Udup Payyappilly, N. Parur

GENERATION IV

- The children of Mathai (III.2) were Xavier (IV.1) George (IV.2) Thomas (IV.3) Cheria (IV.4) Joseph (IV.5) Mary (IV.6) Mathew (IV.7) Thresia (IV.8) and Antony (IV.9).
- IV.1 • Xavier (1896-1968) married Rosa D/o Mr. Cheria Chirammel Avaran, Irinjalaka. He settled at a place near his ancestral house and he worked as the head master of St.Mary's Primary School, Kuzhikkattussery, near the eastern border of Puthenchira. He had 5 sons and 2 daughters.
- IV.2 George (1899-1975) married Kunjannam D/o Porinchu Thachil, N. Kuthiathodu and settled in a house very close to his ancestral house. He was a reputed Abkari Contractor of his time. He had 6 sons and 7 daughters.
- IV.3 Thomas (1902-1972) married Cherchi the first D/o Chakku Chandi, Trichur. A graduate from St.Joseph's College, Trichy, he established a Training College for the intermediate students in Colombo, but closed the institution and returned to India after a few years. Since Chakku Chandy, his father-in-law did not have sons, Thomas took over control of the well established Hardware business of Chakku in Trichur. However he disposed of the business in Trichur and settled down in Puthenchira after finalising the partition deed between his wife and her sisters. He had 5 daughters.
- IV.4 Cheria (1907-76) married Eliakutty. D/o. George Puthokaran, Chengaloor and settled down in Puthenchira. He was a trader & and Abkari Contractor and

was the president of Puthenchira Village Union, the title for the present day Panchayat president. He has 2 sons and 2 daughters

- IV.5 Joseph (1912-1976) married Thresiakutty D/o. Cheriakutty Ullattikulam Chalakudy and settled down in Puthenchira. He rendered service as the Mandalam President of Congress as well as the Panchayat President of Puthenchira. Encashing on the abundance of goodwill which the family enjoyed in the area, he established such a rapport with the people and Mr. Karunakaran, the Honourable Chief Minister of Kerala, that the family name became a password for entry into important positions in Congress and the local administrative bodies in the area. He has 4 sons and 3 daughters.
- IV.6 Mary (1915) joined the Holy Family Convent and adopted the religious name 'Mary Xavier'. On retirement from teaching profession, she is taking rest in the Convent at Kuzhikattussery.
- IV.7 Mathew (1918-1990) married Mary D/o Joseph Valiaveetil Edathuruthy. He has 4 sons and 4 daughters.
- IV.8 Thressia (1921) was married to Mr. Kunjippalu Thottan, Trichur.
- IV.9 Antony (1924) married Mary D/o Mr. Joseph Puthur, Parappur and settled down in his ancestral house. He retired as a graduate teacher. With the demise of his elder brother, Joseph, he became the Mandalam President of Congress in Puthenchira and also the Panchayat President. These positions were held by him until they were relinquished on health grounds with the special consent of the Chief Minister. Aged 70 he is the only living Male Member of the 4th generation of the family and hence the present Karanavar of the Puthenchira Branch of Panikulam family. He has 6 sons and 3 daughters.

The children of Kunjicheria (II.2) were George (IV.10) Mariam (IV.11) Thressia (IV.12) Devassy (IV.13) Joseph (IV.14) and Lonappan (IV.15).

- IV.10 George (1884-1960) married Eliakutty D/o Mr. Poulouse Palathingal, Tripunithura and Settled in Puthenchira. He was a well Known Civil Engg. Contractor of his time. The major jobs undertaken by him include the main Puthenchira P.W.D. Road and the Puthenchira Dam. He had 2 sons and 2 daughters.
- IV.11 Mariam, (1891-1969) adopted the religious name 'Sr. Prasila' on joining the Carmelite Convent.
- IV.12 Thresia was married to Mr. Kunjicheria Manjooran Chakkarakadavu, second brother of Rosa, the wife of Mathai (III.1).
- IV.13 Devassy (1900-80) married Ittiannam D/o Devassy Natakalan, Peringottukara and settled in Puthenchira. He served F.A.C.T. Udyogamandal for few years as a supervisor. He had three sons and one daughter.
- IV.14 Joseph (1905-1980) married Rosamma D/o Mr. Paul Manjaly Thuravoor and

settled in Puthenchira. He served as the post master of Puthenchira Post Office. He had 3 sons and 6 daughters.

- IV.15 Lonappan (1908-1981) married Cherchikutty D/o Mr. Kunjicheria Edattukaran Mala. He settled in his ancestral house, the original Tharavadu of Panikulams in Puthenchira. He had 5 sons and 5 daughters.

GENERATION V

The Children of Xavier (IV.1) were Mathai (V.1) Baby (V.2) Cheriachen (V.3) John (V.4) Kakkappan (V.5) Rosily (V.6) and George (V.7).

- V.1 Mathai (1924) married Annamkutty D/o Mr. Lonappan, Cherpanan, Kadukutty. He settled in his ancestral house and has 2 sons and 3 daughters.
- V.2 Baby (1928) (VI.1) adopted the religious name of Sr. Claudia on joining the Holy Family Convent Kuzhikkattussery.
- V.3 Cheriachen (1930) married Daisy D/o Mr. Varunny Alangadan, Chalakudy. He settled near his ancestral house and has one son and two daughters.
- V.4 John (1932) married Pushpam D/o Mr. Francis Thachil, N. Kuthiathodu. He retired as a Panchayath Executive Officer and is presently holding the position of the Mandalam President of Congress, Puthenchira. He has 3 sons and one daughter.
- V.5 Kakkappan (1936-1961) died before marriage.
- V.6 Rosily (1938) is married to Mr. Antony Maliekal Ollukaran, Edathuruthy.
- V.7 * George (1942) was ordained a diocesan priest in the year 1967. After a short service in a parish and Aluva Seminary he went to Rome in the year 1968 for higher studies. There he obtained degrees in 'Religious Studies' from Gregorian University and in Canon Law from the Oriental Institute and a Doctorate in the New Testament from the Biblical Institute. On completion of a four year training programme in diplomacy in the Vatican Academy of Diplomacy he served in the Vatican embassies of Canada, Venasuvella and Germany. Presently he is occupying the position of a Councilor in the German Nunciature.

He was conferred the title of 'Monsignor' by his holiness, the pope in the year 1980.

He has recently been elevated to the position of the Deputy Head of the Missions in Vatican in which capacity he will be co-ordinating the activities of about 700 missions dioceses situated in different parts of the world. MSGR Dr. George Panikulam is proficient in the western languages of English, Italian, German, French and Spanish. He is the author of 5 books and several articles in English and

Malayalam.

The children of George (IV.2) were Rosy (V.8) Chinnamma (V.9), Mathew (V.10), Sicily (V.11), Francis (V.12), Mary (V.13), Kochumary (V.14), Leelamma (V.15), Jose (V.16), Thomas (V.17), Ittoop (V.18), Antony (V.19), and Rani (V.20).

- V.8 Rosy (1925) is married to Mr. Vareed Thottappilly, Karoor, the then Head Master and Manager of Rajashri Memorial High School, Aloor.
- V.9 Chinnamma (1927) joined the Clarist Convent, and adopted the religious name of Sr. Ensweed'. After her retirement as school teacher she is presently engaged in social work with St. Pauls F.C. Convent, Vellikulangara as the base.
- V.10 Mathew (1929-1993) married Annie D/o Louis Mampilly, Njarakal. He settled down in Bombay after retirement from the position of Security Officer of M/S Wyeth Laboratories, Bombay. He has one son and one daughter.
- V.11 Sicily (1931) joined the Clarist Convent and adopted the religious name of Sr. Ferdinand. After retirement as a school teacher, she is rendering selfless service, despite ill-health, as Asst. Mother of Queen Mary F.C. Convent, Kaippamangalam.
- V.12 Francis (1993) married Alphonsa, D/o George Akkara, Ollur. After retirement from the service of M/s Indian Oil Corporation Limited as Chief Refinery Co-ordinator, he has returned to Puthenchira and settled in his ancestral house. A subject of special interest to him is behavioural science. His published works include "COMPARATIVE JUSTICE", "THE BIG PERSON IMAGE", and "EQUALITY PRINCIPLE". He has one son and a daughter.
- V.13 Marry (1935-1937) died in infancy.
- V.14 Kochumary (1937), joined the missionary order of 'Daughter's of charity' whose headquarters of the Indian Province is situated in Berhampur, Orissa. She adopted the religious name of Sr. Mary Louis. She was elevated to the position of the Mother Provincial of the Indian province of the congregation in 1985. Incidentally, she is the first Indian to be entrusted with this responsibility, the past incumbents being all Spanish sisters. She has successfully completed two terms of service, totalling a period of 9 years as the Mother Provincial.
- V.15 Leelamma, (1939), joined the Carmelite Convent and adopted the religious name of Sr. Dalmatia. Consequent upon obtaining a Doctorate in clinical counselling from Phillippines, she opted for an early retirement from her teaching assignment in Ollur Convent High School and set up a counselling wing in the Vincent De Paul Hospital, Ollur. She also regularly conducts classes and seminars for priests and nuns in the subjects at different parts of the country.
- V.16 Jose (1941) married Mariamma D/o Mr. Iyunni Chirammel Padinjarathala,

Puthenpeedika. He is employed as an executive in Mazagon Docks, Mangalore. He has two sons.

- V.17 Thomas (1944) joined the Jesuit order of priesthood. A gold medalist in his M.A. Malayalam from the University of Kerala and a first Rank holder in the second language in his B.Sc., Father Thomas has translated several books into Malayalam like Fr. Antony De Mello's 'Wellsprings', 'One Minute Wisdom', 'Call To Love', 'Prayer of the frog', etc and has written a couple of booklets - 'Inigo', 'Jesuits - Eesosabha' and so on. Having done his Masters in Biblical studies he has been teaching Bible and related subjects for several years in different Jesuit Seminaries in Bombay, Bangalore, Dindigul and Calicut. As editor of 'Sneha Sena', an illustrated magazine for children, his name, 'Tom Achan' has become a house - hold name in Kerala. Being swift - footed in his younger days he represented St. Joseph College, Devagiri for 200, 400 and 800 mt run and 4 x 100 mt relay and played hockey for Kerala University and Kerala State and was once adjudged the best player of the year in the state. Twice he won the first prize in Kerala short story writing competition both in English and Malayalam. At present he is the Socius (Asst. to the Provincial) of Kerala Province of the society of Jesus and resides in Calicut.
